




Cycling Rules and Regulations in Japan



Generally, cyclists must ride on the road and must always keep to the left side.



Exceptionally, cyclists may cycle on the pavement when the blue sign (as shown) indicating a shared sidewalk is displayed.



Bicycles must be parked in bicycle parking lots.



Helmets are mandatory for children aged 12 and under.



Stop at intersections to ensure safety.



Do not “double-ride”.



Do not cycle in parallel.



Do not use your phone or camera while cycling.



Do not use earphones while cycling.




Do not cycle under the influence of alcohol.
